The quilt show will be held at the DeKalb Middle School on the north side of Auburn and near the Antique Show and official shuttle site. This venue is air-conditioned with plenty of light, free parking and is handicap accessible. Admission is \$5.00.

Expect to see your Judged and General Display quilts displayed attractively in the climate controlled DeKalb Middle School. Vendor's mall is centrally located in the commons area near the Husband's lounge located in the lower level of the commons. Vendors will be open from 9-5:00 Saturday and Sunday and from 6:00-7:00 before Saturday evening's Block Party. Refreshments will be available for your enjoyment and will be provided by DeKalb HS Band Boosters. Nine (9) quilting technique categories with divisions of amateur, professional, or youth are available for quilt entries. 1st Place Winners will receive \$100, 2nd Place Winners will receive ribbons, and Best of Show will be awarded a name brand sewing machine. With your quilt entry, you receive a free ticket for the Saturday Evening Block Party.

Bonnie K. Hunter of Quiltville.com is our guest designer, teacher, author, lecturer, and blogger. Saturday is the first day of the **HOME OF THE CLASSICS QUILT SHOW** and pre-registered students will learn from Bonnie's 6-hour workshop, Boxy Stars. Plan to attend the Saturday night Block Party when Bonnie will share her lovely quilts and tell about her new book, "Scraps and Shirttails" featuring combining recycled clothing, fabrics and scraps for the right look.
