### HCQS Contest Rules for Judged and General Display

1. Categories: **Appliqué** Pro/Amateur/Youth ~ **Pieced** Pro/Amateur/Youth ~ **Mixed Medium** Pro/Amateur/Youth ~ **Group (3+ individuals)** Pro/Amateur/Youth ~ **Wall** Pro/Amateur/Youth ~ **Art** Pro/Amateur/Youth ~ **Postcard, Journal or Miniature** Pro/Amateur/Youth ~ **Wearable** Pro/Amateur/Youth ~ **Hand Quilted** Pro/Amateur/Youth

2. Entrant **must** determine the category in which piece will be entered. Home of the Classics Quilt Show reserves the right to change the category if not submitted into the correct category. One category per entry.

3. No more than three (3) entries per category from one (1) person will be accepted for the Judged selection. No more than two (2) entries will be accepted from any one (1) person for the General display. No more than five (5) entries, total, will be accepted from any one (1) person. All persons involved in making the item must be listed on the entry form.

**4. Non-refundable entry Fee is \$10 per judged entry or \$2 per general display. (Each entrant (person) receives one complimentary ticket to the block party which includes food, vendors, presentation to show winners, and guest trunk show.) A completed entry form MUST accompany each entry. If mailed, entry forms, fees (nonrefundable) and quilts enclosed in a labeled cloth bag must be received at Home of the Classics Quilt Show, POBox 386, Auburn IN 46706 by Friday, August 28, 2009. Hand delivered forms, fees, and items enclosed in a labeled cloth bag must arrive at the First Methodist Church on East Seventh Street, Auburn IN between 9:00 and 2:00 on Monday, August 31, 2009. Make checks/money orders payable to Home of the Classics Quilt Show or HCQS.**

#### **HAND DELIVERED ITEMS:**

Released items may be picked up from **DeKalb Middle School, Sunday, September 6, 2009, 6:00-8:00.**

**Claim ticket must be presented.** Please note we are allowing the vendors to break down before the displayed items will be released. **SHIPPED ITEMS:** All quilts will have been return shipped by September 8, 2009 according to your enclosed shipping instructions.

5. Quilts must be constructed of three (3) layers, and be quilted by hand, machine or both. Wearables should include some piecework, appliqué or embellishment.

6. HCQS reserves the right to not judge or display any soiled or damaged item.

7. All entries must have been completed within the last five (5) years and not previously displayed at HCQS.

8. An identification label **MUST** be on all entries with name, address and telephone number. It is requested that each quilt have a 4-inch sleeve, except for postcard, journal, miniatures, and wearables.

9. Dimensions: Miniature quilts must have a perimeter no larger than 100"- 144" total, with blocks no larger than 3 inches. Postcards will be 4"x 6". Journals will be 8 to 8-1/2" x 10 to 11". Wall quilts must have a perimeter between 144"- 240". Bed quilts must measure at least 60" on the short edge.

10. **Prizes: Best of Show:** Name Brand Sewing Machine. **1<sup>st</sup> place winners:** \$100. **2<sup>nd</sup> place:** Ribbon  
Each entry item displayed will receive a quilt label from HOME OF THE CLASSICS QUILT SHOW.

\*A Professional is defined as one who teaches quilt making, judges quilts, has published quilting books or patterns, sells, designs, or quilts as a profession, or has won placement or monetary awards in two or more competitions in nationally recognized venues, or in shows where the total award disbursement is \$10,000 or higher. If any person who participated in the entry is classified as a professional by this definition, the entry must be entered in the professional category. HCQS reserves the right to make final determinations of "Professional". \*\*Youth: 18 and under
