### **HCQS Contest Rules for Juried and General Display**

1. Categories: **Appliqué** Pro/Amateur/Student ~ **Pieced** Pro/Amateur/Student ~ **Mixed Medium** Pro/Amateur/Student ~ **Block-of-the-Month or Kit** Pro/Amateur/Student ~ **Group (3+ individuals)** Pro/Amateur/Student ~ **Wall** Pro/Amateur/Student ~ **Art** Pro/Amateur/Student ~ **Postcard, Journal or Miniature** Pro/Amateur/Student ~ **Garment** Pro/Amateur/Student ~ **Other** ~Pro/Amateur/Student
2. Entrant **must** determine the category in which piece will be entered. Spinning Spools Quilt Show reserves the right to change the category if not submitted into the correct category. One category per entry.
3. No more than three (3) entries per category from one (1) person will be accepted for the Juried selection. No more than two (2) entries will be accepted from any one (1) person for the General display. No more than five (5) entries, total, will be accepted from any one (1) person. All persons involved in making the item must be listed on the entry form.
4. Entry Fee is \$10 per juried entry or \$2 per general display. A completed entry form **MUST** accompany each entry. Entry forms, CD (juried only) and entry fees (nonrefundable) must be postmarked by **July 25, 2008.** Make checks/money orders payable to Home of the Classics Quilt Show or HCQS.
5. Quilts must be constructed of three (3) layers, and be quilted by hand, machine or both. Garments should include some piecework, appliqué or embellishment.
6. Entries must not be soiled or damaged in any way.
7. Juried entries must have been completed within the last five (5) years.
8. A permanent identification label **MUST** be on all entries with name, address and telephone number. Quilts are required to have a 4-inch sleeve, except for postcard, journal and miniatures quilts.
9. Anyone may enter the juried portion of the show by submitting a CD, a completed entry form and \$10 fee per entry. Send one CD per entry, one full view and one close up. Mark each CD with your name and the name of the item.
10. Dimensions: Miniature quilts must have a perimeter no larger than 100"- 144" total, with blocks no larger than 3 inches. Postcards will be 4"x 6". Journals will be 8-8-1/2" x 10-11". Wall quilts must have a perimeter between 144"- 240". Bed quilts must measure at least 60" on the short edge, but not more than 110" on the longest edge.
11. **Prizes: Best of Show:** Name Brand Sewing Machine. **1<sup>st</sup> place winners:** \$100. **Other:** Ribbons  
Each entry item displayed will receive a quilt label from HOME OF THE CLASSICS QUILT SHOW.

\*Professional quilter: Someone who teaches, publishes or has won money and has received or earned \$10,000 or more a year in the field of quilting. Prizes awarded total over \$3,000.00.

### HOME OF THE CLASSICS QUILT SHOW SHIPPING INSTRUCTIONS FOR JURIED AND GENERAL DISPLAY ITEMS

After submitting Entry fees of \$10 per Juried entry and \$2 per General Display entry by July 25, 2008, juried participants will be notified by mail of their acceptance.

All quilts **must** be shipped to arrive between August 15 and August 19, 2008. They **MUST BE RECEIVED AT THE SSQG OFFICE BY AUGUST 22, 2008.** See hand delivered items instructions below.

Ship your entry(s) to Spinning Spools Quilt Guild, P.O. Box 386, Auburn, IN 46706

Follow these steps to ship your entry:

1. Photograph the entry prior to mailing. Place the photo and a copy of the paid entry form in a labeled envelope.
2. Please enclose a copy of the insurance form in the envelope with the photo.
3. Ship the entry in a box that is sturdy enough to be used for return shipping.
  - a. Place entry item in labeled cloth bag (name, address, phone number), then in plastic bag prior to placing in box.
  - b. Label the box on the outside and inside. **RETURN POSTAGE AND INSURANCE MUST BE PREPAID;** place the return postage and insurance information in the envelope with the photo.
  - c. Ship to the above address using US Postal Service to ship your items. Include two (2) return address labels in the envelope. We suggest use of signature confirmation shipping
4. If you display or enter more than one quilt/item, each must be packaged and shipped separately.

### HAND DELIVERED INSTRUCTIONS FOR JURIED AND GENERAL DISPLAY ITEMS

Hand delivered items may be delivered to NATMUS on Friday, **August 22, 2008** between 9:00am and 2:00 pm. Each entry should be placed in a labeled (name, address, phone number) cloth bag and include a copy of paid entry form.

Spinning Spools Quilt Guild will take every precaution to ensure the safety of your quilted item while in our care, possession and control. If you wish to insure your item, the insurance for it will be your responsibility.

#### ENTRY SUBMISSION TIMETABLE

##### **JURIED ITEMS: *Received by July 25, 2008***

Properly labeled and identified CD containing two (2) views of item to be juried, completed Juried Entry Form, and \$10 Juried Entry Fee (Payable to Home of the Classics Quilt Show or HCQS) must be sent to Spinning Spools, P.O. Box 386, Auburn, Indiana 46706 for each juried entry. Hand-stamped date must be readable. Entries must be postmarked by July 18, 2008 and received by July 25, 2008.

##### **GENERAL DISPLAY ITEMS: *Received by July 25, 2008***

Completed General Display Entry Form and \$2 General Display Entry Fee must be sent to Spinning Spools Quilt Guild by July 25, 2008

#### NOTIFICATION TIMETABLE FOR JURIED ENTRIES

##### **JURIED ITEM NOTIFICATION: *Mailed July 31, 2008***

All Juried entrants will be notified by mail by July 31, 2008 of their acceptance for the Juried portion of the quilt show. (No notifications prior to this date.) You will receive complete shipping directions with your notification.

#### SHIPPING TIMETABLE

##### **SHIPPING: *Received by AUGUST 22, 2008***

All quilts must be shipped to arrive between August 15 and August 19, 2008. They *MUST BE RECEIVED AT THE SPINNING SPOOLS QUILT GUILD OFFICE BY AUGUST 22, 2008.* Please follow shipping instructions fully.

##### **HAND DELIVERED ITEMS: *Received Friday, August 22, 2008 9:00-2:00***

Hand delivered items may be delivered to NATMUS on Friday, August 22, 2008 between 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.

#### ENTRY RETURN TIMETABLE

##### **HAND DELIVERED ITEMS: *Released from NATMUS, Sunday, August 31, 2008***

Hand delivered and released items may be picked up from NATMUS on Sunday, August 31, 2008, 6:00-8:00 p.m. Please note we are allowing the vendors to break down before the quilted items will be released.
